HOW TO FILL UP THE DIVISIONAL APPLICATION OF A NATIONAL PHASE ENTRY APPLICATION FORM

TO BE FILLED UP BY IPOPHL

Application No. - This is the application number issued by the IPOPHL for the specific application submitted (e.g. 1-2013-500001). When this application number is issued, all communications/actions intended for this application number should contain said number.

Date of Receipt – This is the “actual date” when the International Application has been received and entered into the Office’s receiving system by the Duty Officer of the day.

Date of Mailing – This is the stamped date of the Post Office when the divisional application is mailed to the Office. The “Date of Mailing” shall be considered as the Date of Receipt under Section 8, of Rule 13 of the Rules of Court.

TO BE FILLED UP BY THE APPLICANT

[] Invention – The applicant is to mark this box if he/she intends to file the divisional application as an invention application.

[] Utility Model – The applicant is to mark this box if he/she intends to file the divisional application as utility model application.

I. Parent Application No. – The applicant is to indicate the original national phase entry application number that the divisional application is being derived from.

II. Date of National Phase Entry of the Parent Application – The applicant is to indicate the date when the parent application entered the national phase in the Philippines.

III. International Application No. - The applicant is to indicate the international application number of the parent application he/she wishes to apply in IPOPHL (e.g. PCT/US2011/000001)

IV. International Filing Date – The applicant is to indicate the international date of filing of the parent application.

V. Language of Application – The applicant is to indicate the original language the of the parent application that was filed in the IB.

VI. International Publication No. - The applicant is to indicate the publication number given by the IB when parent application was published (e.g. WO2011/123456)

VII. International Publication Date - The applicant is to indicate the date wherein the parent application was published by the IB.

VIII. Language of International Publication – The applicant is to indicate the language of publication of the parent application by the IB.

IX. Title of Invention/Utility Model – The box should be edited and the box should only contain the words “Title of Invention” if the divisional application is intended to be an invention application and the title of the international application should be indicated in the box. The same treatment should be made if the intended divisional application is to be a utility model application.

X. Earliest Priority Date Claimed – The date/s of earlier application/s the applicant wants to claim for the divisional application which was/were also claimed as a priority by the parent application.

XI. Applicant(s) – This is the owner of the application. The applicant’s complete name and address should be indicated.

XII. Inventors(s)/Maker(s) – The applicant is to mark the appropriate boxes to indicate whether the inventor/s or maker/s are the same as in the international publication or if there are changes the list and the IB was not able to include it in the international publication.

XIII. Check List – The applicant is to indicate of the number of sheets which composes the divisional application.

XIV. Claim – The applicant is indicate the number of claims the applicant wishes to pay for the divisional application.

XV. Agent (if any) or Common Representative (if any) in the Philippines – The name and Philippine address of the person who will prosecute the international application for the applicant. (Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations for Patents, Utility Model and Industrial Design. Rule 421)

XVI. Signature or Applicant(s) or Agent over printed name(s) – The signature authenticates that the divisional application of a national phase entry application form is valid for acceptance as an application.
